Pakistan became the seventh country of world and first Islamic country to have nuclear power in 1998 because of Dr. Abdul Qadeer Khan.

Nuclear energy can be used in very constructive way. If we do nuclear reactions in controlled manner as in reactors so we can utilise this energy to overcome our daily life needs. The heat generated during fission of 1kg of Uranium equals the energy released by burning 10 3000 tons of coal. This enormous amount of energy can be used to produce electricity, run turbines and as a fuel for many appliances, but on other hand this energy is exposed to humans in terms of


